FILM SYNOPSIS

Each summer, the grounds surrounding the Garst Museum in Greenville, Ohio, fill with artists, craftspeople, musicians, historical interpreters and characters from more than two centuries of American history. Gathering at Garst | Where Ohio History Comes to Life begins with Fort Greene Ville, the Battle of Fallen Timbers and the 1795 Treaty of Greenville before stepping inside the Gathering's living-history encampment. There, the film explores the everyday skills through which generations experienced history - cooking, textiles, blacksmithing, trade, traditional crafts, military life and historical medicine.

Verdigris Market Garden is a Columbus, Ohio-based herbal business and educational media platform exploring the connections between plants, gardens, traditional skills, agriculture, history and seasonal living.
